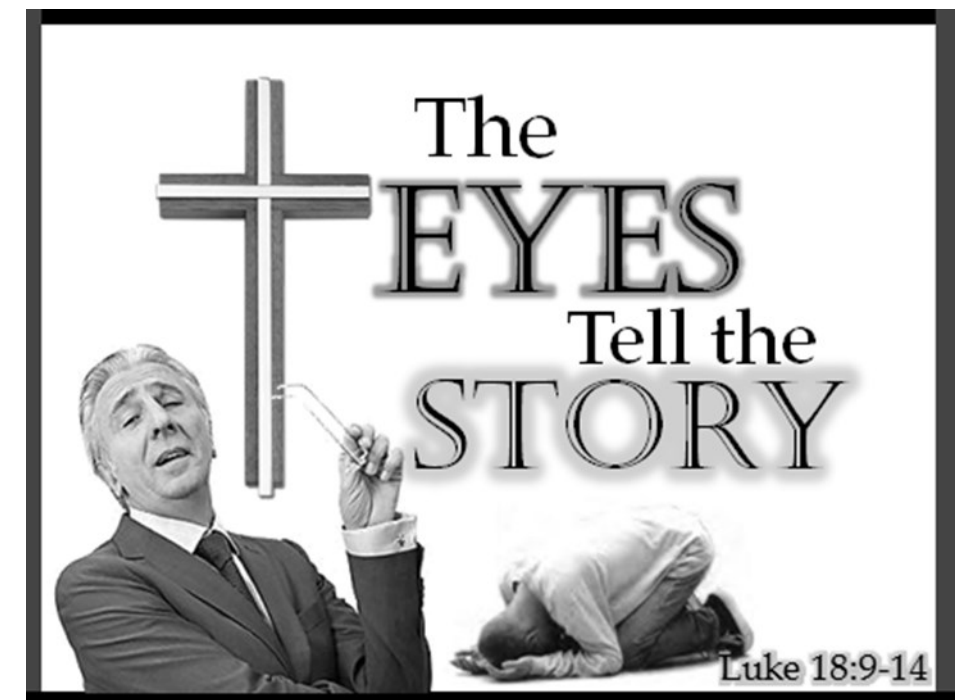
SCHOOL FUNDRAISER
