CANDY NEEDED



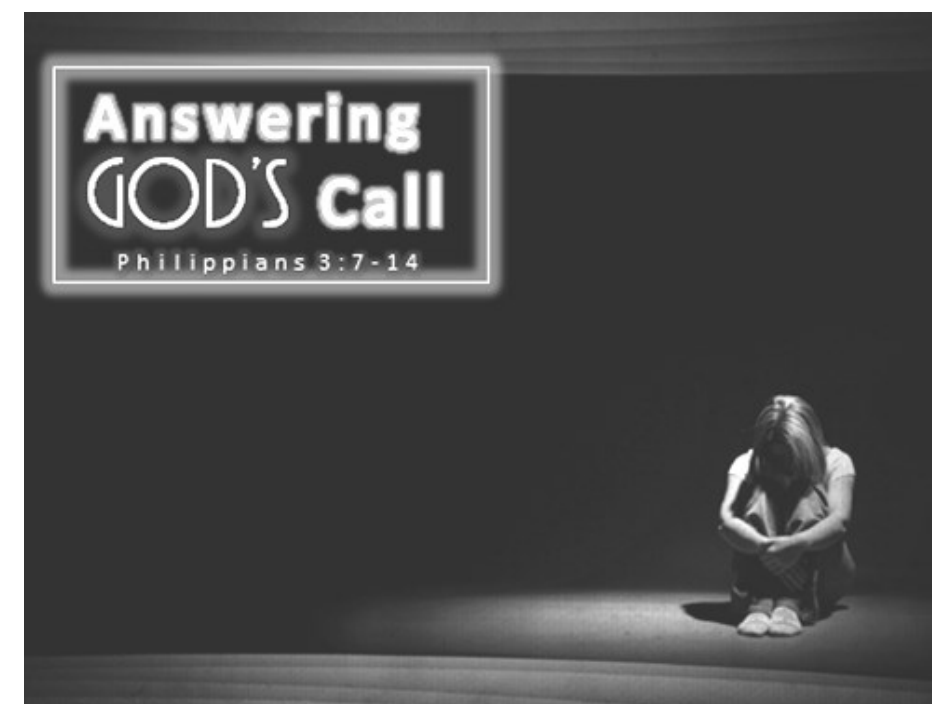
