### TRUNK OR TREAT

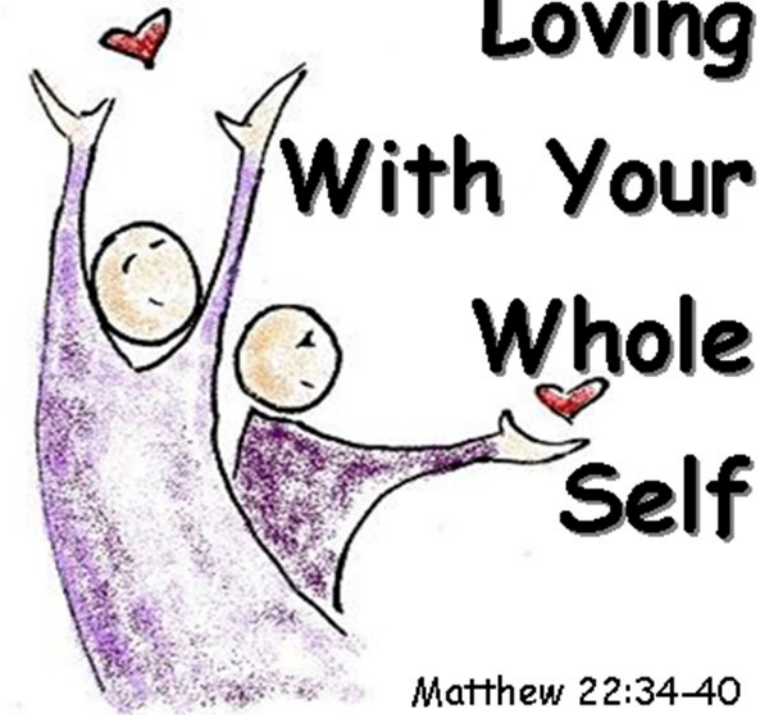


