### UNITED METHODIST WOMEN



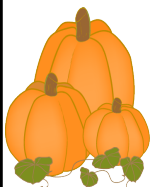


