Please take a moment to write a note in their Bibles prior to today's Service. The Bibles will be presented to the graduates during the luncheon.

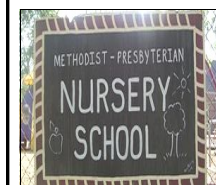

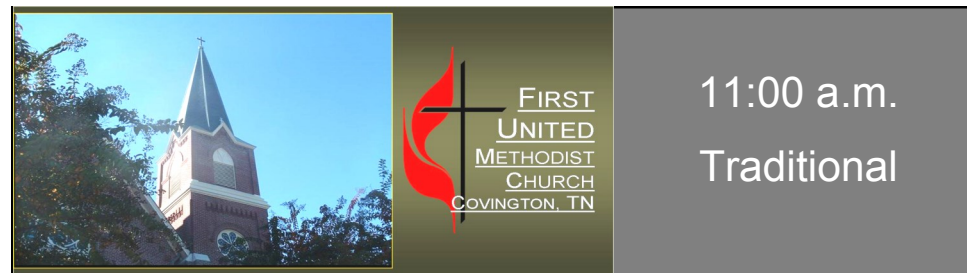
