Rev. Diane Harrison joins us today from Grace Place United Methodist Church located in the Mark H. Luttrell Correctional Center. Grace Place UMC is the first prison-based mission congregation in the Southeastern Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church.

Operating as an extension ministry since 2007, Grace Place UMC was approved as a mission congregation in 2012 and officially began services in 2013. With the help of many volunteers from area United Methodist churches, inmates can participate in small group activities like Bible study, book club, crochet ministry and exercise classes. Weekly activities of the church total about 14 hours per week and serve up to 20 inmates weekly.

Rev. Harrison served as Program Director and Associate Pastor at Covington FUMC from 1998-2002. Next Sunday's communion offering will benefit Grace Place UMC.

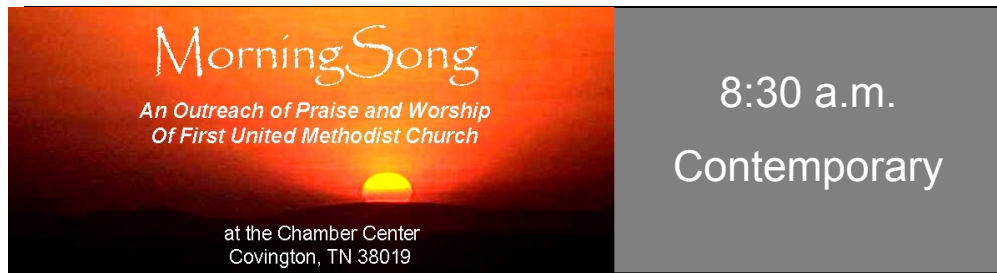

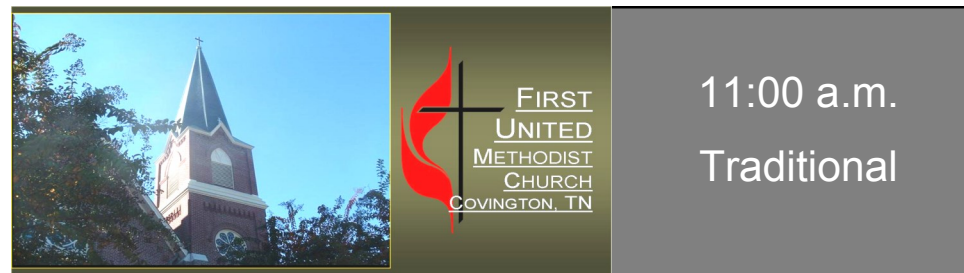
