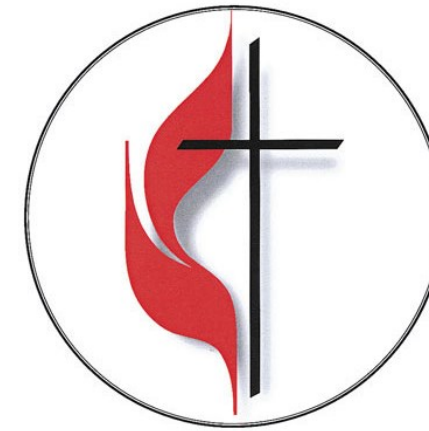


CHARGE CONFERENCE FOR CHURCH LEADERSHIP

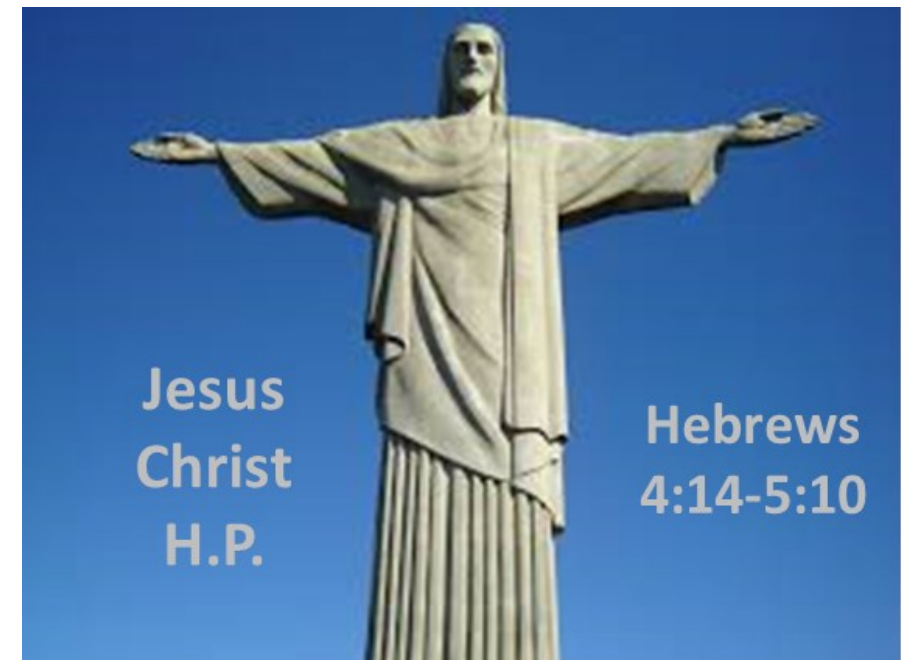


