Sermon Notes: "A Giving Attitude"

The longer I live the more I realize the impact of "attitude" on life. "Attitude", to me, is more important than facts. It is more important than the past, than education, than money, than circumstances, than failures, than successes, than what other people think or say or do. It is more important than appearance, giftedness or skill. It will make or break a company . . . a church . . . a home. The remarkable thing is we have a choice every day regarding the attitude we will embrace for that day. We cannot change our past . . . we cannot change the fact that people will act in a certain way. We cannot change the inevitable. The only thing we can do is play on the one thing we have, and that is our Attitude . . . I am convinced that life is 10% what happens to me and 90% how I react to it.
