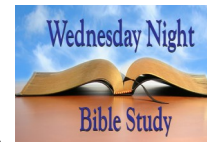
WEDNESDAY NIGHT PROGRAMS

ASH WEDNESDAY



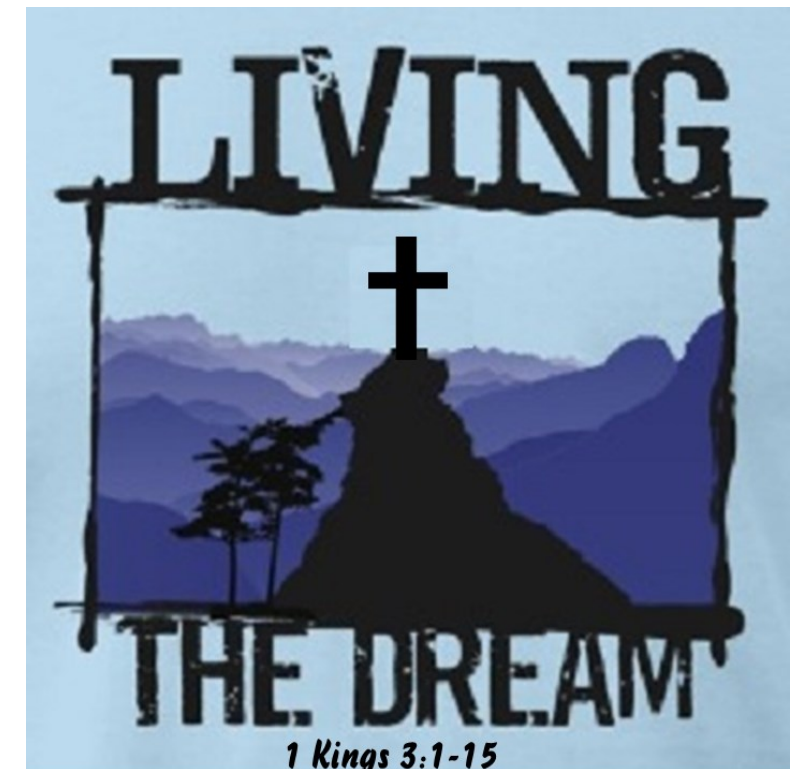

Traditionally on this day, a cross is marked on the forehead (or on the palm of the hand) in ash as a sign of repentance in preparation for the great festival of Easter. Our schedule for observance of Ash Wednesday is a Come and Go Imposition of Ashes in the Sanctuary from 7:00-8:00 a.m. and an Ash Wednesday service at 6:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary.
