Please join us for the weekly Men's Prayer Breakfast every Thursday at 7:00 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall; the cost is \$3.

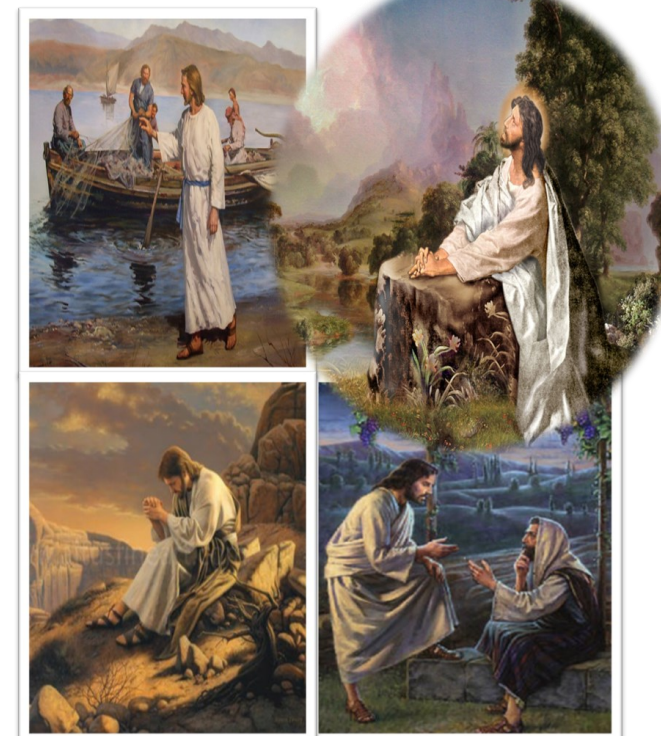
