Minute Summary

Rev. Cox announced that 386 people attended the Christian Life Center dedication service 9/7/14. He spoke about the need for a vision for the CLC and FUMC Covington overall.

Items covered by the various committees were:

- Our church will have a new pictorial directory and tentative dates for photos are December 9-13th of this year.
- December 14th is the date for our **one worship** Christmas Cantata with Church-wide attendance at the 11:00 a.m. hour and a potluck breakfast from 8:30-9:30 a.m. before Sunday school.
- A firm is looking into water damage to the Fellowship Hall and will present a recommendation for a plan of action to be considered at the next meeting.
- There will be a one day “Jesus Loves Tipton County” event on October 25th organized by Covington area churches. More information will be follow.
- Grace is meeting with representatives from each Sunday school class to discuss opportunities for our Church to serve at the new Boys and Girls Club.
- Faye Beckett will have additional training classes in January 2015 for persons interested in Congregational Care Ministry.
- A charge conference will be held November 9, 2014 at the 11:00 a.m. worship for celebration of ministry and election of church leaders.
- Rev. Cox has been asked by our Bishop to further his education and pursue a Doctorate of Ministry which will require him to be away from the church in two week increments, twice a year beginning in 2015. However; as he learns, his preaching and leadership will be enhanced by his studies. SPRC and Administrative Board both voiced their support.
- Finance submitted a report from Robert Wooten, CPA, with several recommendations to consider for improved financial accountability.
- Sandy Burgess will be the coordinator for the Christian Life Center and Kenny Summers will assume additional responsibilities in the care of the CLC.
