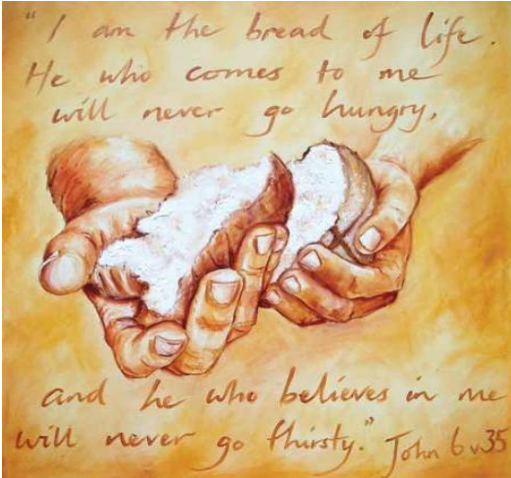


# Bread of Life Feeding Ministry Update
